Western loop

This 16km journey takes riders past the National Museum of Australia and the National Arboretum Canberra, across Scrivener Dam, and past the National Zoo & Aquarium and the Government House Lookout. It continues on through the leafy Westbourne Woods near the Royal Canberra Golf Club, and then past the Canberra Yacht Club and across Commonwealth Avenue Bridge.

Cycling time: up to 1.5 hours – some hills

Highlights

- Explore our history at the National Museum of Australia
- Have an animal encounter at the National Zoo & Aquarium
- Ride through the tranquil Westbourne Woods
- Enjoy a scenic cruise on Lake Burley Griffin
- Watch the sail boats as you enjoy fish and chips at the Canberra Southern Cross Yacht Club
- Take a guided e-bike tour of the lake, or hire a stand up paddle board or paddle boat
- Take a detour up to the National Arboretum Canberra and Dairy Farmers Hill Lookout for spectacular views of Canberra

Central loop

Known as the 'bridge to bridge', this 4.9km loop from Kings Avenue Bridge to Commonwealth Avenue Bridge takes in the National Triangle. Home to many of the city's national galleries, museums, and attractions, this area is popular with locals and visitors alike — especially during weekends. You will be riding along the RG Menzies and Australians of the Year walk.

Cycling time: up to 40 minutes – mostly flat

Highlights

- Ride along the lake's edge when the Captain Cook Memorial Jet is in full spray or the National Carillon is playing
- Wander through Reconciliation Place to see the outdoor sculptures
- Experience the fun of science at Questacon — The National Science and Technology Centre
- Take a peek inside the Museum of Australian Democracy at Old Parliament House
- Walk through the National Gallery of Australia's Sculpture Garden
- Chat to the friendly staff at the Canberra and Region Visitors Centre

Eastern loop

This 9km route takes riders past the Kingston Foreshore precinct towards Fyshwick and through the Jerrabomberra Wetlands Nature Reserve, returning back towards the lake's Central Basin.

Cycling time: up to 1 hour – mostly flat

Highlights

- Drop into the Old Bus Depot Markets between 9.30am-2.30pm on a Sunday to taste foods from all over the world and buy regional art, craft, and produce
- View glassblowing demonstrations at the Canberra Glassworks every Wednesday to Sunday
- Ride through Bowen Park in early spring to see the magnificent trees in blossom
- Wander the myriad of Jerrabomberra Wetlands tracks to see wildlife
- Enjoy a unique adventure on Lake Burley Griffin by renting an electric picnic boat with GoBoat

Safe cycling

- Cyclists, children in a child carrier, or passengers in a trailer must wear an Australian standards approved helmet
- Watch for people walking and remember they are often distracted and may stray into your path. Use your voice, bell, horn or other device to let others know you are coming
- Front and rear lights must be used when riding at night
- Cyclists have right of way on green cycling paths on ACT roads
- Cyclists are allowed to ride on footpaths and should keep left where possible
- Clear hand signals when turning or changing lanes are required.
